

**Alma de Cattleya 2018 Pinot Noir****93 points**

The nose is graphite, pulverized stone, violet and spiced ripe plum with a silky, floral palate entry mixed with red and black stone fruits. Very well put together, the mid-palate offers texture and length without a lot of mass. Delicate dry fruit on the finish.

**Alma de Cattleya 2018 Chardonnay****90 points**

The nose is chalk, lemon and pineapple, vanilla bean and butter cream. The palate entry is slippery, buttered lemon crème with notes of toasted citrus and nuts in the core through lively acidity on the finish.

**Alma de Cattleya 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon****90 points**

The nose is dried herb, spiced chocolate, and soaked cherry leading to a velvety and dense palate entry of dried plum, mocha and cedar. The mid-palate continues with a medium-weight spiced fruit. Again, well put-together wine that is clearly made for near-term enjoyment and with that in mind, it works.
